


Year 2



Through the keyhole

Through this topic the children will learn the following:

Science	<p>Identify a human's basic needs.</p> <p>Recognise the impact exercise and hygiene has on humans. Know that things move differently on different surfaces.</p> <p>Understand that materials are chosen for their properties.</p>
Geography	<p>Use photos, aerial photos and maps to create a map of Thatcham.</p> <p>Draw a simple map of Thatcham.</p> <p>Use geographical vocabulary to describe the human features of Thatcham- include town, office, and factory.</p>
History	<p>Recognise how Thatcham has changed.</p> <p>Plan questions and produce answers to prove how Thatcham has changed.</p> <p>Understand why a particular person is significant in the history of Thatcham.</p>
Music	<p>To be able to talk about the pitch, dynamics and tempo in a piece of music.</p> <p>To create a graphic score and choose instruments and sounds to represent each part.</p> <p>To create and play a steady and strong pulse.</p>
Art and design	<p>To draw simple cartoons. (visiting artist)</p> <p>Investigate marks made through printing with scrunched paper and other materials.</p>
Design and technology	<p><u>Technical Knowledge/Evaluate design</u></p> <p>Identify mechanisms used for movement- pivots, swings, turning. Investigate and analyse products in play parks</p> <p>Design, make and evaluate a play park that incorporates mechanisms for turning, swinging and pivots.</p> <p>Evaluate their design and product against the design criteria</p>
Computing	<p><u>E-safety and Microsoft Word-</u></p> <p>Keep personal information private.</p> <p>-Be kind online.</p> <p>-Know to tell an adult about something which concerns you.</p> <p>Keyboard skills/logging on to computers</p>
